Operator Certification Exam Development and Administration

This **FREE** session is being offered with operators in mind who are looking to take any level Drinking Water Operator Certification Exam as well as their managers. This presentation is intended to give you an understanding of the processes that go into developing and administering the exam in Massachusetts.

The Division of Professional Licensure is now working with the Association of Boards of Certification (ABC) and Applied Measurement Professionals, Inc. (AMP) to implement new testing procedures. The exam procedure will now involve the use of computerized exams offered throughout the year at designated locations. These procedures were developed to make the exams more convenient for potential operators and reduce the cost for the exams.

This session will give insight into ABC's role in the development of the exam, as well as the Board of Certification of Operators of Drinking Water Supply Facilities' role. The new computerized component will also be discussed to better prepare you and/or your employees for taking the exam.

DIRECTIONS TO WACHUSETT MOUNTAIN SKI AREA
Route 140, Princeton, MA

Wachusett Mountain Ski Area is easily accessible from Route 140 in Westminister. There is excellent signage to guide you from Route 140 to the Mountain.

From Worcester (20 minutes)

Take Rt. 290 East to Exit 19 for 190 North. Take Exit 5 off 190 North, which will put you onto 140 North. Follow 140 North for nine miles to the access road on the left.

From Boston (1 hour)

Take Rt. 2 West to Exit 25 for Rt. 140. Follow Rt. 140 South to the access road on the right.

From Providence (1 1/4 hours)

Take Rt. 146 North to Rt. 290 East to Rt. 190 North. Take Exit 5 Rt. 140 North. Follow Rt. 140 North for nine miles to the access road on the left.

From Hartford, Ct. (1 1/2 hours)

Take Rt. 84 East to the Mass Pike East to Exit 10 Auburn to Rt. 290 East to Rt. 190 North to Exit 5 Rt. 140 North. Follow 140 North for nine miles to the access road on the left.

From Nashua, N.H. (1 1/4 hours)

Take Rt. 130 West to Rt. 13 South to Rt. 2A West to Rt. 140 South.

OR Take Rt. 3 South to Rt. 495 South to Rt. 2 West. Take Exit 25 Rt. 140 South. Follow Rt. 140 South to the access road on the right.
